NFDA Initiative Award DIRECTIONS

If fewer than three nominations are received for the NFDA Initiative Award in any year, NFDA may, at its sole discretion, decline to give the Initiative Award in any particular year.

I. <u>CRITERIA FOR NOMINATION</u>

Women who are nominated must meet the following four criteria:

- 1. Employed in funeral service with a minimum of five years industry experience (a funeral director's license is not required).
- 2. Actively involved in community and professional service organizations.
- 3. Actively involved in public relations or educational programs that give the public a better understanding of funeral service.
- 4. Participant in deathcare continuing education programs or courses during the past two years.

II. SUBMISSIONS

The nominating party shall submit the following forms and items:

- A. Award Criteria form
- B. Nomination Fact Sheet
- C. Award Recommendation
- D. Letters of Recommendation.

NFDA INITIATIVE AWARD NOMINATION GUIDELINES

- I. In the event that NFDA does not receive a sufficient number of applications for the award, NFDA may, at its sole discretion, decline to give the Initiative Award in any particular year.
- **II.** Nominations meeting the established criteria will be evaluated by a panel of judges. Decisions of the judges are final. Submissions will not be returned.
- **III.** A standard evaluation form, based on established criteria, will be used to judge each nomination.
- **IV.** The nominee who receives the highest evaluation will receive the 2012 INITIATIVE AWARD, to be presented at the Professional Women's Conference in April 2012.
- **V.** The nominating party and his or her winning nominee will be informed via mail of the results. Other *nominating parties* will also be informed via mail of the results.

NFDA Initiative Award CRITERIA

1.	Verify that nominee is a woman who has been employed a minimum of five years in the deathcare industry or a deathcare-related industry and who is currently employed in that industry. Attach verification.

3. Identify nominee's current involvement in public relations or educational programs that give the community a better understanding of funeral service.

4. Identify nominee's educational and/or continuing education participation during the past two years.
