NFDA ENGLAND - 6 NIGHTS, INCLUDING VISITS TO SELECT FUNERAL HOMES

Monday, June 6: Depart the United States Depart your hometown and take an overnight flight across the Atlantic.

Tuesday, June 7: London Arrival After landing at London Heathrow Airport, complete customs and immigration formalities before transferring on your own to the hotel. Check in and settle into your room before spending the remainder of the day at leisure. Art lovers can view some of the world's finest art collections in London's galleries such as the National Gallery or the Victoria and Albert Museum. If shopping appeals to you, London offers a huge array of shops and designer boutiques. Try the popular stores along Oxford Street, the special boutiques of Bond and Jermyn Streets or the famous Harrods in Knightsbridge. In the evening take advantage of London's worldwide reputation for its entertainment or choose from the many restaurants of all types. *Overnight London (B)*

Wednesday, June 8: London Guided Tour This morning, set off on a guided tour to see some of London's best-known landmarks. View the West End, Piccadilly Circus, Trafalgar Square and much more. Stop to visit the mighty Tower of London to see the many fortresses, Beefeaters, ravens and the priceless Crown Jewels. Last, stop to visit Westminster Abbey with its glorious medieval architecture, impressive tombs and monuments. Afterwards, spend the balance of the day free to sightsee, shop and dine on your own. *Overnight London (B)*

Thursday, June 9: Day at Leisure to Explore London or an Included Excursion to Bath After an authentic English breakfast, board your luxury coach and journey through England's beautiful countryside and into Bath. Visit the Roman Baths, which are over 2,000 years old and one of the best-preserved Roman sites north of the Alps. Also, visit the Pump Room, which dates from 1795, and is one of the most famous buildings in the country. After your Bath excursion, return to your hotel and enjoy the remainder of the day free to relax or explore London at your own pace. *Overnight London (B)*

Friday, June 10: Cotswolds Today, depart London and travel through the beautiful and hilly countryside of the Cotswolds. Here, the houses are mainly built of the local honey-colored stone and see quaint villages, which have remained almost unchanged for 200 years. Next, travel into Oxford for a panoramic tour of the city. See famous landmarks like the Oxford American Cemetery, Oxford University, the Oxford Canal, and much more. Continue on to Stratford-Upon-Avon, and check into your hotel room before joining your group for a traditional English dinner. *Overnight Stratford (B, D)*

Saturday, June 11: Stoneleigh Park Spend the day attending the **National Funeral Exhibition (NFE)**. The National Funeral Exhibition is a respected global platform for the funeral profession and the largest trade show for the sector in the United Kingdom; showcasing the latest, innovative products, inspiring thought leadership and business networking opportunities to 4,500+ funeral sector professionals. One of the top three funeral trade shows in the world, the biennial NFE provides an opportunity for the industry to meet, innovate, buy, sell and see which direction the industry is heading in, in a future-focused environment. *Overnight Stratford (B)*

Sunday, June 12: Stratford-Upon-Avon At Leisure Spend the day free in Stratford-upon-Avon. You may wish to visit Tudor World, which allows you to experience life during the sixteenth century. Perhaps you would like to visit the Mechanical Art and Design Museum, which showcases kinetic art and along with automata that was created by artist from around the world. Another option for the day would be a gentle Riverside Walk around the River Avon. *Overnight Stratford (B)*

EXTENSION TO IRELAND - 8 NIGHTS, INCLUDING A VISIT TO A LOCAL FUNERAL HOME

Spend longer in Europe! Ohio Funeral Directors Association is offering an exciting one-week program in Ireland. After the NFDA England program, take a short flight from Birmingham (35 min. from Stratford) and fly to Dublin, Ireland to join the following tour:

Monday, June 13: Dublin Arrival Take an **included flight** to Dublin Airport. Then meet your driver/guide who will welcome you to Ireland. Next, take an orientation drive around Dublin city center. Highlights include 18th century Georgian houses with brightly painted doors, tranquil parks, and wide O'Connell Street. Take a guided walking tour through Trinity College to view the Book of Kells. In the evening, enjoy a drink with your group before dinner. *Overnight Dublin (D)*

Tuesday, June 14: Enjoy the delightful scenery of the Wicklow Mountains on the way to Glendalough, a stunning example of Ireland's beauty. Explore the remains of one of the most important monastic sites in Ireland, founded by St. Kevin in the 6th century. Walk through the deep valley to view the picturesque ruins of a round tower, churches, and Celtic crosses. Head southeast to the Dunbrody Famine Ship, an authentic reproduction of an 1840's vessel that brought desperate Irish emigrants fleeing famine to the New World. Continue on to the city of Waterford, where (before dinner) you will take a stroll around the streets of the city with a local guide. *Overnight Waterford (B, D)*

Wednesday, June 15: Witness the creation of crystal masterpieces during your visit to the House of Waterford Crystal. Travel to Cobh for a guided walking tour – this harbor town was the last port of call for the Titanic in 1912 and was also the main point of embarkation for Irish emigrants between 1848 and 1960. Proceed on to Blarney, to visit Blarney Castle and see the famous "Stone of Eloquence" or explore the tranquil gardens. Journey west through rugged countryside and settle in to your hotel in Killarney. *Overnight Killarney (B, D)*

Thursday, June 16: Spend the day golfing (arrange on your own) or join a tour exploring Ireland's most popular scenic drive, the Ring of Kerry, with plenty of photo stops along the way. Stop for lunch, then take a stroll around Sneem and stop at Moll's Gap for its panoramic views. Enjoy the evening in Killarney for dinner on your own. *Overnight Killarney (B, L)*

Friday, June 17: Embark on a ferry ride across the River Shannon Estuary. Travel along the coast of County Clare. View the Cliffs of Moher, which soar almost 700 feet above churning Atlantic swells. Walk along the top of the cliffs to O'Brien's Tower for great views of Galway Bay and the Aran Islands. Head to Galway and join a local guide for a stroll through the streets of the old city before spending time on your own. *Overnight Galway (B, D)*

Saturday, June 18: Stop in the pilgrimage town of Knock to see one of the world's leading Catholic shrines. Visit the church where villagers saw a vision of the Virgin Mary in 1879. Immerse yourself in Irish farm life during a visit to an authentic working farm and watch trained sheepdogs round up mountain sheep. Head to Donegal for some free time in this charming town. Proceed to Derry and meet a local guide to discover the history of this ancient city that retains its fortified medieval walls dating from 1613. *Overnight Derry (B, D)*

Sunday, June 19: Explore the northern coastline and the Giant's Causeway - enormous hexagonal columns formed by volcanic activity over 60 million years ago. Visit Titanic Belfast and learn about the ill-fated ship through state-of-the-art displays. See the docks where the famous liner was built just over a century ago. Stop at the Glyde Inn for a farewell dinner with Irish specialties and entertainment featuring traditional Irish music and songs. *Overnight Dublin (B, D)*

Monday, June 20: Enjoy the day touring Dublin independently on the Hop-On, Hop-Off bus. Use your voucher to visit one of Dublin's attractions: Guinness Storehouse, Teeling Distillery, or EPIC The Irish Emigration Museum. In the evening, dine independently. *Overnight Dublin (B)*

Tuesday, June 21: Program concludes. After breakfast, transfer to the airport for flights home. (B)



Important Information

Airfare: International airfare is NOT included and should be booked arriving to London and returning home from Birmingham. If electing the extension, fly to London and home from Dublin. Do not make air reservations until advised by World of Travel. If electing the extension, the flight from Birmingham to Dublin is included.

Cancel for Any Reason Travel Protection: A new "insurance" feature which allows for you to cancel for any reason, up to 48 hours in advance, and receive a minimum of a 75% refund is available. If you cancel for a valid medical reason, you will receive up to a 100% refund. Travel protection rates are based on program selection and room occupancy and will be displayed during the online booking process.

NFDA Registration Fee: \$150 USD/person

Deposit: A deposit of \$1000 USD/person is due upon booking and to secure your reservation. If joining the extension to Ireland, the deposit is \$2000 USD/person.

Final Payment and Cancellation Deadline: March 1, 2022. Cancellations made after this date are non-refundable unless you have elected travel protection and cancel for a covered reason.

Passport: A passport is required. All passports must be valid for six months beyond the date of travel.

COVID-19 Statement: As the departure date nears, WOT will provide updates on any COVID-19 restrictions for travel.



Terms & Conditions

Deposit and Final Payment: A deposit of **\$1000 per person** is due upon booking and to secure your reservation. If joining the optional extension to Ireland, the deposit is **\$2000 per person**. Final payment is due on or before **March 1, 2022**.

Optional Travel Protection: The Travel Insured Group Deluxe Travel Protection Plan is available for your purchase. The schedule of protection coverage and the other services are listed below. Some benefits are time sensitive, including the “Pre-existing Condition Waiver,” so we encourage the purchase of the plan at the time of initial trip deposit. This has to be the first and only booking for the travel period and you are not disabled from travel at the time you purchase the travel protection plan (if you have a pre-existing condition, we highly recommend you call Travel Insured International to confirm if you would be covered in the event of cancellation from a pre-existing condition). Cancellation Penalties with Travel Insured: Should it become necessary for you to cancel or interrupt your trip due to a covered reason as stated in the protection plan, a claim will be filed with Travel Insured International. All cancellations must be received in writing. Cancellations made before **March 1, 2022** are subjected to a cancellation administrative fee of \$100 per person and/or protection plan premium.

Cancellation Penalties without or Not Covered by Travel Insured: All cancellations must be received in writing. Cancellations made before **March 1, 2022** are subject to a cancellation handling fee of \$100 per person. Cancellations made after **March 1, 2022** are non-refundable.

Cancel for Any Reason: CFAR coverage is up to 75% of the prepaid, nonrefundable trip cost (subject to \$20,000 maximum). CFAR is optional and available for individuals. Trip cancellation must be 48 hours or more prior to scheduled departure.
